## The meeting of the WIGOS Vision Update Group and the meeting of the Standing Committee on Earth Observing Systems and Monitoring Networks (SC-ON)

#### WMO Headquarters, Geneva, Switzerland

## 28 April – 2 May 2025

WMO will be organizing the Standing Committee on Earth Observing Systems and Monitoring Networks (SC-ON) meeting, along with the WIGOS Vision Update Group meeting, at WMO HQ in Geneva, Switzerland:

- The WIGOS Vision Update Group meeting will take place on **28 and 29 April 2025**.
- The SC-ON meeting will follow from **30 April to 2 May 2025**.

The events will be conducted face-to-face; however, remote access will be made available in case any participant is not able to attend in person.

The main objective of the SC-ON meeting is to establish a workplan of the Standing Committee, with expected deliverables to the fourth session of the Infrastructure Commission (INFCOM-4) to carry out the mandated normative work for the establishment and evolution of surface- and space-based observing networks, and necessary coordination among subgroups and with other Standing Committees and Advisory Groups.

The main objective of the WIGOS Vision Update Group meeting is to develop the first-order draft of the Vision for the WMO Integrated Global Observing System 2050, which aims at describing the state of the global observing system, with space- and surface-based components, in the 2050 timeframe, for the target audience of space agencies/operators, national and international agencies in charge of in-situ, ground, ocean- and air-based observing systems networks, private and public actors, in the business of designing and deploying observing systems in general. The meeting will also discuss the strategy and plan for the community engagement in developing and reviewing the draft Vision.
