I am pleased to inform you that at the kind invitation of the Government of France, the twelfth Regional Association (RA) I (Africa) Training Course on Tropical Cyclones for meteorologists or hydrologists involved in tropical cyclone forecasting will be held in La Réunion, France, from 22 to 26 September 2025.

The Training Course will be conducted in English and French, at the Regional Specialized Meteorological Centre (RSMC) Tropical Cyclone Centre La Réunion. The course will provide training for tropical cyclone forecasters from the region, assist RA I Tropical Cyclone Committee members in their efforts to improve operational tropical cyclone forecasting and warning, and help participants to understand the emergency decision-making process and communicate efficiently with the relevant stakeholders.

I am therefore pleased to invite you to nominate a forecaster from your Service to participate in this Training Course. To ensure the effectiveness and positive impacts of the course on the work of your service, it is strongly recommended that the nominated forecaster is currently engaged in tropical cyclone and associated weather forecasting, and has a direct link to the operational tasks of your Service. An outline of the programme is enclosed herewith (Annex I). The Information Note for participants will be made available in due course.

Due to limited funds available for this event, it is hoped that your Service could cover the expenses relating to the attendance of your nominated participant. However, upon request, the WMO could consider providing financial support for travel (most economical route) and lump sum amount in lieu of per diem for the participation of your nominated expert. If such assistance is required, kindly indicate it in the nomination form (Annex II).

OUTLINE OF PROVISIONAL PROGRAMME

The aims of this Training Course are to increase participants' theoretical and practical knowledge of tropical cyclones with particular emphasis on analysis and forecasting techniques, and to efficiently message the users of:

- Climatology of the South-West Indian Ocean cyclone basin
- The tropical cyclone genesis and structure
- Tropical cyclone track and intensity forecasting
- Satellite analysis techniques (Dvorak Technique, use of microwave and scatterometer data)
- NWP interpretation
- Tropical Cyclone seasonal and intraseasonal forecasting
- Understanding and communicating on TC Impacts

Additionally, the participants will be invited to make presentations as regards the operational forecasting and public weather service delivery of their own services.
