Following your application and successful selection for the Winter School on Nowcasting Techniques from 14 to 25 July 2025, to be hosted by the University of Buenos Aires, Argentina, I am pleased to invite you to participate in this training event.

I wish to inform you that your participation will be supported by WMO through the World Weather Research Programme (WWRP), the Education and Training Programme (ETRP), and the Korean Trust Fund (KTF). Please ensure you obtain relevant approval from your supervisor and/or Permanent Representative to WMO. The Concept Note (Annex I) and List of Participants (Annex II) are attached for more information.

Due to limited funding availability, WMO will provide the following support to facilitate your participation; a lump-sum Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA) of US\$ 140 per day to cover accommodation, meals, and incidental expenses during the training, a most direct and economical return air ticket, and a lump-sum payment of US\$ 252 for terminal expenses related to airport transfers.

In addition, you are kindly requested to inquire about an entry visa to Argentina and check with the concerned travel agent if a transit visa is required. Please contact Professor Paola Salio at paola.salio@gmail.com for a visa support letter.

Regarding insurance coverage for non-staff members, may I draw your attention to the following:

Non-staff members of WMO who are authorized to travel at the Organization's expense and/or who are receiving a DSA from WMO must ensure they are fully responsible for expenses incurred in the event of death, illness or injury during official travel and attendance at meetings on behalf of the Organization. They are, therefore, fully responsible for arranging life, health, and accident, as well as any other forms of insurance with an adequate level of coverage for the duration of such meetings and events.

WMO liability is limited to the performance of services or attendance at a meeting on behalf of the Organization, is covered by an injury and illness benefit insurance which provides limited coverage for medical, emergency, and supplementary official travel expenses.

The Winter School on Nowcasting is organized by the University of Buenos Aires, in collaboration with the Co-Chair of the WMO WWRP Nowcasting and Mesoscale Research Working Group. It is supported by the WMO World Weather Research Programme (WWRP), the Education and Training Programme (ETRP), and the Korea Meteorological Administration (KMA) Trust Fund.

This training supports WMO Strategic Objectives 3.1, 4.2, and the Early Warnings for All initiative (EW4ALL) by enhancing the capacity of National Meteorological Services to provide timely, impact-based forecasts. It focuses on equipping early-career meteorologists, particularly from least-developed and vulnerable regions, with practical nowcasting skills and communication tools to better respond to extreme weather.
