Dear Sir/Madam,

On behalf of the World Meteorological Organization and the Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission of UNESCO (IOC-UNESCO), I am pleased to announce that at the kind invitation of the Collecte Localisation Satellites (CLS), Toulouse, an extraordinary session of the Argos Joint Tariff Agreement (JTA) will take place in Brest, France, 18 November 2017.

At the last JTA meeting the decision was made to have JTA meetings every 4 years, and authorizing the JTA Executive Committee to make changes to the tariff structure as long as it is consistent with the 4-year plan. As significant changes to the 4-year plan are being proposed, it has been decided to organize a short (1-day) extraordinary JTA meeting.

This meeting will be held immediately after the thirty-third session of the Data Buoy Cooperation Panel (14-17 November 2017), to which invitations were issued through a separate letter.

Attendance at the meeting can be in person or via video or teleconference. The Provisional Agenda and related working documents, local information and video and teleconference information for the session will be available on the website at http://www.jcomm.info/JTA-Extraordinary2017. The session will be conducted in English only.

It is to be noted that the meeting has been organized as a measure to promote the use of the Argos system for the location of and data collection from buoys and other platforms, both ocean and land based, by securing a preferential tariff for authorized users. We therefore have the pleasure of inviting your representative to this session.

We should be grateful if you would inform the WMO Secretariat by **30 September 2017** whether you will be represented at the meeting in person and, if so, of the name of your representative. It may be noted that, according to established procedures, financial assistance by IOC or WMO will not be available for the participation of delegates at the meeting.
