Severe Weather Forecasting Demonstration Project – Regional Subproject for the Bay of Bengal (SWFDP-BoB) – First Meeting of the Regional Subproject Management Team (RSMT), and Regional Training Workshop on Severe Weather and Impact Based Forecasting and Warning Services to be held back-to-back in Colombo, Sri Lanka,28 November- 1 December 2018, and 3-8 December 2018

- (1) the designated representative from your Service to attend the first Meeting of the Regional Subproject Management Team (RSMT) of SWFDP-BoB in Colombo, Sri Lanka, from 28 November to 1 December 2018
- (2) one operational forecaster to participate in the Regional Training Workshop on Severe Weather and Impact Based Forecasting and Warning Services, in Colombo, Sri Lanka from 3 to 8 December 2018
- (3) one public weather services (PWS) staff to participate in the Regional Training Workshop on Severe Weather and Impact Based Forecasting and Warning Services, in Colombo, Sri Lanka from 3 to 8 December 2018

Dear Sir/Madam,

As you may recall, the development of the Severe Weather Forecasting Demonstration Project Regional Subproject for Bay of Bengal (SWFDP-BoB) which currently benefits nine countries in South Asia started in January 2012 with a Technical Planning Workshop on SWFDP Development in New Delhi, India, with participation from six countries (Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka and Thailand). SWFDP-BoB mainly focuses on improving forecasting and warning services for hazardous weather including especially monsoon induced heavy rain, strong winds and thunderstorms by making best use of the Numerical Weather Prediction (NWP) including Ensemble Prediction System (EPS) products and satellite information made available from contributing global and regional centres through SWFDP. Capacity development of the operational forecasters and public weather services staff of the National Meteorological and Hydrological Services (NMHSs) in improving their skills is a salient feature of SWFDP. The project has been supported through a joint WMO-RIMES project with funding from United Nations ESCAP. The password protected web portal of the subproject (http://nwp.imd.gov.in/mme/fdp-bob/login.php) has been developed and maintained by Regional Specialised Meteorological Centre (RSMC) New Delhi, the lead regional centre for the subproject. The contributing global centres include NWP Centres of India, Japan, UK; and the ECMWF.

The subproject is to be managed by a Regional Subproject Management Team (RSMT) which mainly consists of the designated representatives of the participating NMHSs and contributing global and regional centres. The designated representatives of the NMHSs are

To: Permanent Representatives (or Directors of Meteorological or Hydrometeorological Services) of Members of WMO (limited distribution: Bhutan, Bangladesh, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan and Thailand)

Directors or senior forecasters of national forecasting offices. The RSMT is normally chaired by the lead regional centre and responsible for review and updating of the Regional Subproject Implementation Plan (RSIP).

As part of our efforts to move the SWFDP-BoB to its demonstration phase, WMO Secretariat has planned the meeting and training workshop to be held back-to-back in Colombo, Sri Lanka. In this context, you are invited to kindly consider from your Service participation of the following:

- (1) a designated focal point for SWFDP-BoB to attend first Meeting of the RSMT from 28 November to 1 December 2018. He/she should preferably be Director or a Senior Forecaster from national forecasting office. A list of designated focal points as updated during 2016-2017 is attached herewith (see Annex A)
- (2) one operational forecaster to participate in the Regional Training Workshop on Severe Weather and Impact Based Forecasting and Warning Services, in Colombo, Sri Lanka from 3 to 8 December 2018
- (3) one public weather services staff to participate in the Regional Training Workshop on Severe Weather and Impact Based Forecasting and Warning Services, in Colombo, Sri Lanka from 3 to 8 December 2018

The main objective of the RSMT meeting is to review the subproject progress and update the draft RSIP with its future activities including to introduce and strengthen impact based forecasting and warning services in the sub-region and to define timeline for demonstration phase of the subproject. The regional training workshop is aimed to provide training on NWP interpretation and its best use in severe weather forecasting and to develop capacity of the participating NMHSs on impact based forecasting and warning services including through engagement with users (e.g. disaster management and civil protection authorities), and prepare the NMHSs to effectively contribute during demonstration phase of the subproject. Working documents of the RSMT meeting and provisional training program for the regional workshop will be made available at WMO website on the following link:

The nomination form (one per participant) should be completed and returned to the WMO Secretariat at your earliest convenience but **preferably not later than 31 October 2018**.
