Subject: Invitation - Meeting of the Steering Group for the Severe Weather

Forecasting Demonstration Project (SWFDP), Pretoria, South Africa

14-18 October 2019

Action required: To notify the Secretariat on or before 10 August 2019

Dear Sir/Madam,

As you may be aware, the Steering Group for Severe Weather Forecasting Demonstration Project (SWFDP), established in 2005 under the Commission for Basic Systems (CBS), is mainly responsible to provide guidance and monitor the progress of SWFDP and its regional subprojects. Started in 2006 with the involvement of just five countries in southeastern Africa, SWFDP currently involves over 75 developing countries, least developed countries (LDCs) and small island developing states (SIDS) in eight sub-regions of the world. The Steering Group for SWFDP generally meets every 2 or 3 years to review the project progress. The last meeting of the steering group was held in Geneva, Switzerland in March 2016. The WMO Executive Council at its seventieth session (EC-70) adopted Resolution 1 (EC-70) - Consolidated approach to severe weather forecasting. The joint independent reviews of the SWFDP, Flash Flood Guidance System (FFGS) and Coastal Inundation Forecast Demonstration Project (CIFDP) were carried out during 2018-2019 to assess the effectiveness, efficiency, impact, relevance and sustainability of each of the three initiatives and for developing a consolidated approach. The Eighteenth World Meteorological Congress (Cg-18, June 2019) noted the outcome of the joint independent reviews and recommendations for a consolidated approach.

I am therefore pleased to inform you that at the kind invitation of the Government of South Africa, a meeting of the Steering Group for SWFDP is scheduled to be held in Pretoria, South Africa from 14 to18 October 2019. The meeting will consider relevant decisions/outcomes of Cg-18. It is also expected to suggest recommendations to the technical commissions on implementation of the Cg-18 decisions related to SWFDP. WMO Flood Forecasting Initiative (FFI), CIFDP and Seasonal Forecast experts have also been invited to attend the meeting.

In this regard, I would like to invite you to nominate an expert from your Service to participate in this meeting. The list of the members of the Steering Group is available as Annex I. Given the limited funds available for the meeting, it is hoped that your Service will meet the cost of participation of your nominated expert. However, if this is not feasible, WMO, upon request, could consider covering the cost of participation for your expert including airticket, and/or per diem.
