Action required: To send the monitoring results to the WMO Secretariat not later than

Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish to inform you that the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) proposes to carry out a specific monitoring on the exchange of Antarctic data from 1 to 15 January 2020. All Antarctic collection stations, National Meteorological Centres (NMCs) and centres with similar functions located on the principal routes by which Antarctic meteorological data enter the Global Telecommunication System (GTS)

(see ftp://ftp.wmo.int/GTS_monitoring/SAM/From_WMO/preparation/RA Antarctic GTS-1.pdf), Regional Telecommunication Hubs (RTHs) and the World Meteorological Centres (WMCs), as regards telecommunications (see Attachment I-3, *Manual on the Global Telecommunication System* (WMO-No. 386)), which are operated by the Members concerned, are requested to participate in the specific monitoring. The results received from these centres will be analysed by the WMO Secretariat.

Operators of meteorological satellites providing services for the collection of Antarctic data are also invited to participate in the specific monitoring activities. To this effect, a copy of this letter is being sent to the Director-General of the European Organisation for the Exploitation of Meteorological Satellites (EUMETSAT).

In accordance with the importance of monitoring data presented in table-driven code forms (BUFR, CREX), the procedures of the specific monitoring on the exchange of Antarctic data have been extended for the monitoring of surface and upper-air observations from fixed stations presented in table-driven code forms and are available at: ftp://ftp.wmo.int/GTS_monitoring/SAM/From_WMO/preparation/1_Procedures.pdf.

In order to avoid duplication in the transmission of monitoring reports, it is proposed that NMCs, sending their IWM (Integrated WWW Monitoring) reports to their associated RTHs, and the RTHs sending the IWM reports to the WMO Secretariat, for the period from 1 to 15 January 2020, do not send the corresponding reports of this specific monitoring to the Secretariat.

I should be grateful if you could agree to participate in the monitoring on the exchange of Antarctic meteorological data, and send your monitoring results on electronic media to the WMO Secretariat at your earliest convenience, but not later than **1 March 2020**.
