Dear Sir/Madam,

The Commission for Basic Systems (CBS) Open Programme Area Group (OPAG) on Data-Processing and Forecasting System (DPFS) is supported by three Expert Teams, namely the Expert Team on Operational Weather Forecasting Process and Support (ET-OWFPS), the Expert Team on Operational Prediction from Sub-seasonal to Longer time-scale (ET-OPSLS) and the Expert Team on Emergency Response Activities (ET-ERA).

In preparation for the upcoming sixteenth session of the Commission for Basic Systems (CBS-16) in November 2016, and at the kind invitation of Canada, I have the pleasure to inform you that the Expert Team is planning to meet in Montreal, Canada, from 9 to 13 May 2016, to review, discuss and prioritize new work plan items for the intersessional period 2016-2019. These items include: (a) verification methods for high-resolution models; (b) use of additional observation types for verification; (c) calibration of model output; (d) exchange of EPS products; (e) implications throughout the forecast chain for high-resolution NWP; (e) implementation of the new *Manual on the Global Data-processing and Forecasting System (GDPFS)*; (f) impact-based forecasting, including for land transportation and mega cities; (g) rolling review of user requirements; (h) partnerships to ensure success of integrated service delivery; and (i) cascading forecasting process and seamless approach.

The membership of ET-OWFPS (see Annex) includes an expert from your country, nominated during the fifteenth session of CBS (Jakarta, Indonesia, September 2012). I should, therefore, be grateful if you would kindly confirm your consent to his/her attending the meeting.

In accordance with WMO General Regulation 37, the "expenses of attendance of members of working groups of constituent bodies at sessions of these groups shall normally be borne by the members to which those members belong". It is, therefore, hoped that these expenses will be borne by your Government.

If it is not possible for your Government to meet the expenses for the attendance of your expert, WMO is prepared to consider providing financial support for this purpose. However, in view of the limited funds available to support meetings of working groups, I would request you to consider the possibility of meeting at least part of the costs involved

If WMO meets the travel costs, the travel arrangements will be made by the Secretariat and details will be sent directly to your expert in due course.
