Dear Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, the WMO Regional Association V called for biennial session of the RA V Tropical Cyclone Committee (RA V TCC) for the South Pacific and South-East Indian Ocean (Resolution 15, RA V-17, Nuku'alofa, Tonga 15–17 October 2018). The Government of Tonga has agreed to host the RA V TCC-18 in Tonga, from 28 to 31 July 2020.

However, due to the worldwide pandemic of COVID-19 and after consultation with the President of RA V and the Chairperson of RA V TCC, it has been decided to conduct the RA V TCC-18 in the same week as indicated above, but in the form of videoconference with a series of three meetings, as follow;
