Subject: Support for the development of standard climatological products and

improving the exchange of data through WIS and WIGOS

Action required: Nomination of two or more focal points before 20 September 2021

Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish to inform you that the World Meteorological Organization under the umbrella of the Climate Risk and Early Warning Systems (CREWS) initiative signed an agreement with the Direction Générale de la Météorologie, Morocco, to support the Central and West African National and Meteorological Services (NMHSs) with training sessions to (i) develop standard climatological products (climatological normals CLINO, monthly climatological averages WWR, National Climate Monitoring Products NCMPs) and (ii) improve the exchange of data through WIS and WIGOS.

This support will involve:

- (1) An opening session with Permanent Representatives and Focal Points (data exchange, climate data management) on 27 September 2021;
- (2) Regular briefings with NMHSs' Focal Points to collect and update staff needs;
- (3) Online trainings and support delivered to individual countries to identify work plans and implement them.

The WMO-DGM Arrangement has been established in line with the recommendations and outcomes of the Regional Training Workshop on Data Collection, Management, Exchange and Quality Monitoring in West and Central Africa (June 2020) and the Data Conference (November 2020).

I would be grateful if you could consider nominating three focal points for the three activities as reflected in the agreement. Focal points are crucial for the success of the work in the frame of this agreement, I would like to encourage you to nominate skilled experts in the relevant fields of expertise (fill in the table of the designated focal points in Annex 1).
