I am pleased to inform you that the third WMO Workshop on Operational Climate Prediction (OCP-3) will be held at Instituto Portugês do Mar e da Atmosfera (IPMA) in Lisbon, Portugal, from 20 to 22 September 2022. The purpose of the workshop is to continue facilitating the dialogue among global, regional and national operational climate prediction centres, and to strengthen the partnership between the operational and research communities. I would therefore appreciate if you could kindly examine the possibility of your expert(s) identified in the Annex, attending and presenting at and/or chairing a session of the workshop.

I should be grateful if you could notify the Secretariat at your earliest convenience, but not later than **24 June 2022**, and indicate whether any financial assistance will be required.

Regarding insurance coverage for non-staff members, may I draw your attention to the following:

"In the case of non-staff members of the Organization who are authorized to travel at its expense and/or who are receiving a daily subsistence allowance, WMO accepts limited responsibility for compensation in the event of death, illness or injury attributable to attendance at meetings or the performance of services on behalf of the Organization. These persons are therefore fully responsible for any expenses incurred as a result of events which are not attributable to attendance at meetings or the performance of services on behalf of the Organization and for arranging such life, health and other forms of insurance as they consider appropriate".

Travelers should also note that WMO Regulations and Rules do not cover additional costs arising from the prolongation of stay of experts or other costs arising from travel restrictions imposed by national authorities. As with related health insurance provisions it is

incumbent on the traveller to ensure that they retain the necessary travel insurance protection to cover unexpected occurrences such as border closures or other travel restrictions.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support to the activities of WMO.
