WWRP Urban-PREDICT Project Steering Group Face-to-Face Meeting and Urban City Workshop

Hong Kong, China, 3 - 7 November 2025

We are delighted to announce that the Urban-PREDICT Steering Group Meeting will take place from 3 to 5 November 2025 in Hong Kong, China. This meeting will provide an excellent opportunity to discuss ongoing research, strengthen collaborations, and outline future priorities for our working group. Following the Steering Group meeting, two complementary activities are planned: a Public Day on 6 November 2025, featuring presentations from the URBAN group, WMO/WWRP, and local Hong Kong experts on climate risk management and urban resilience, with the participation from government agencies (e.g., Hong Kong Observatory, Development Bureau, Drainage Services Department), academia, corporate sectors (banking, utilities, real estate, insurance), and humanitarian organizations such as the Hong Kong Red Cross.

On 7 November 2025, participants will join a Sponge City Visit, gaining first-hand exposure to Hong Kong's pioneering "sponge city" approach — an innovative stormwater management system that mitigates flooding, optimizes land use, and promotes sustainable urban development. Together, these events will foster dialogue between science, policy, and practice, while highlighting sponge city solutions as a key pathway for building climate resilience in urban environments.
