Subject: Forty-eighth session of the RA IV Hurricane Committee (HC-48), Cancún,

Quintana Roo, México, 2-5 March 2026

Action required: To complete the Nomination Form to be submitted to the WMO Secretariat

on or before 12 January 2026

Dear Sir/Madam,

I have pleasure in informing you that, at the kind invitation of the Government of Mexico, the forty-eighth session of the RA IV Hurricane Committee (HC-48) will be held in **Cancún, Quintana Roo, México, from 2 to 5 March 2026.** The HC-48 session will be followed by the Regional Subprogramme Management Team (RSMT) of the Severe Weather Forecasting Programme for the Caribbean (SWFP Caribbean) from 6 to 7 March 2026.

The function of the Committee may be broadly described as, among others, the coordination and improvement of hurricane forecasting and warning services, thereby reducing the number of casualties and the amount of damage resulting from hurricanes in the Region.

According to Resolution 2 (RA IV-19, Phase I), your country is represented in this Committee. I am therefore pleased to invite you to nominate an expert responsible for tropical cyclone forecasting to attend the session. The nomination form is attached herewith (annex). A provisional annotated agenda and information note for the session will be made available in due course. Members of the RSMT SWFP Caribbean are invited to nominate one representative who will also attend the back-to-back RSMT meeting to strengthen synergies between the Tropical Cyclone Programme (TCP) and the SWFP, and to improve cost efficiency.

In accordance with WMO General Regulation 31, the "expenses for the attendance of members of subsidiary bodies of constituent and additional bodies at sessions of these bodies shall normally be borne by the Members or the international organization to which those members belong." It is, therefore, hoped that your government would consider covering the cost of participation of your nominated expert. However, upon request, WMO could consider providing financial support (travel and a lump sum in lieu of per diem) for the participation of your nominated expert.

To clarify WMO insurance coverage for non-staff members before they undertake travel, please advise participants in the above-mentioned meetings, as follows:

"Non-staff members of WMO who are authorized to travel at the Organization's expense and/or who are receiving a DSA from WMO must ensure they are fully responsible for expenses incurred in the event of death, illness or injury during official travel and attendance at meetings on behalf of the Organization. They are, therefore, fully responsible for arranging life, health, and accident, as well as any other forms of insurance with an adequate level of coverage for the duration of such meetings and events.

WMO liability is limited to the performance of services or attendance at a meeting on behalf of the Organization, is covered by an injury and illness benefit insurance which provides limited coverage for medical, emergency, and supplementary official travel expenses."

For administrative purposes, I should be grateful if you could notify the WMO Secretariat (acfontan@wmo.int, ymochizuki@wmo.int and btapia@wmo.int) on or before 12 January 2026, of the attendance of your nominated expert, and whether financial assistance would be required.
