The World Meteorological Organization (WMO) and the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) have entered into an agreement for the implementation of a four-years project Building regional adaptive capacity and resilience to climate variability and change in vulnerable sectors in the Andes, a contribution to the currently ongoing regional project Enhancing Adaptive Capacity of Andean Communities through Climate Services (ENANDES) (hereafter referred to as "ENANDES+"). This new contribution will support Argentina, Bolivia, Ecuador and Peru in the provision of weather, water and climate (WWC) services.
