As you may be aware, the Central America Flash Flood Guidance System (CAFFGS), Haiti and Dominican Republic Flash Flood Guidance System (HDRFFGS) and Northwest South America Flash Flood Guidance System (NWSAFFGS) are currently operational and various major activities have been successfully completed.

At the kind invitation of the Instituto Meteorológico Hidrológico de Panamá (IMHPA), the Joint Steering Committee Meeting, Refresher and Step 5 training, of CAFFGS, HDRFFGS and NWSAFFGS in Panama City, Republic of Panama, will be held from 24 to 28 April 2023.

The objectives of these events are to review project status, review the fundamental concepts and products; illustrate the use of FFGS products and FFGS enhancements; provide feedback on the system's operational use in the region, and to discuss the future goals, the development, and implementation of the CAFFGS, HDRFFGS and NWSAFFGS enhancements in the region, provide capacity-building for the provision of flash flood early warnings. This meeting will be attended by the Permanent Representatives, the Hydrological Advisers, and the FFGS Focal Points of all country members.

In this regard, I am pleased to invite the following participants for different events as listed below:

- The Permanent Representative, Hydrological Adviser, FFGS Focal Point, and alternate focal point of your country are invited to attend this Steering Committee Meeting held from 24 to 25 April 2023 (2 days). We would like you to also nominate a Representative from your National Disaster Risk Management Agency to attend this meeting. The purpose of his/her attendance would be to suggest how to optimize the use of FFGS in your country, adapting it to the current framework of disaster risk management.
- Three operational forecasters (FFGS Focal point, alternate focal point and one newcomer with meteorology and hydrology backgrounds using the FFGS in your country), to attend the training meeting from 26 to 28 April 2023 (3 days).

Kindly be informed that during the Steering Committee Meeting, each country is required to provide a PowerPoint presentation that should focus on the operational status of their respected FFGS region, case study, future goals, flash flood forecasting, and early warning capabilities in their country.

Please note that each participant is required to take the introductory FFGS online courses as a prerequisite to this training (the links are in the annex). During the refresher training courses, participants are required to have their laptops in order to do the exercises, quizzes, and preparing case studies by using the system.

The World Meteorological Organization (WMO) will cover the travel-related expenses and provide full-board accommodation.
