I am pleased to inform you that Oman Meteorological Department, Muscat in collaboration with the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) Secretariat is planning a Workshop on Impact-based Forecast and Warning Services to be held in Muscat, Sultanate of Oman, from 5 to 9 November 2023. The Workshop will invite participants from the Panel on Tropical Cyclones and Gulf Countries Council (PTC/GCC) countries and responds to a recommendation made by PTC-45 in 2018.

WMO liability is limited to the performance of services or attendance at a meeting on behalf of the Organization, is covered by an injury and illness benefit insurance which provides a limited coverage for medical, emergency, and supplementary official travel expenses."
