Action required: RAV TCC-22 and SWFP-SP RSMT: Completed nomination forms to be submitted to the WMO Secretariat on or before **30 April 2024**

Dear Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) Regional Association V (RA V) called for annual sessions of the RA V Tropical Cyclone Committee (RA V TCC) for the South Pacific and South-East Indian Ocean prior to the tropical cyclone season (Resolution 1, RA V-18, virtual session).

I am pleased to inform you that, at the kind invitation of Australia, the RAV TCC-22 will be organized from 30 July to 1 August 2024, back-to-back with the SWFP-SP RSMT meeting on 2 August 2024. The function of the Committee may be broadly described as, among others, coordination and improvement of the tropical cyclone forecasting and warning services, and thereby, the reduction of casualties and damage resulting from tropical cyclones in the Region. The RSMT is expected to review the progress of SWFP-SP and its potential contributions to the United Nations (UN) Early Warnings for All initiative.

I am further pleased to invite you to nominate a representative of your country to participate in the RA V TCC-22 session and RSMT meeting. Please find attached herewith the nomination form (Annex I) and the list of the members of the RSMT (Annex II). The draft agenda will be made available in due course at the session/meeting website.

Given the limited funds available for the RA V TCC session and RSMT meeting, I should be grateful if you would kindly **consider nominating the same participant to attend both events.**

In accordance with [WMO General Regulation 31](#), the "expenses for the attendance of members of subsidiary bodies of constituent and additional bodies at sessions of these bodies shall normally be borne by the Members or the international organization to which those members belong." It is, therefore, hoped that your government would consider covering the cost of participation of your nominated expert. However, upon request, WMO could consider providing financial support (travel and a lump sum in lieu of per diem) for the participation of your nominated expert.

Regarding insurance coverage for non-staff members, may I draw your attention to the following:

WMO liability is limited to the performance of services or attendance at a meeting on behalf of the Organization, is covered by an injury and illness benefit insurance which provides a limited coverage for medical, emergency, and supplementary official travel expenses."
