Subject: Invitation to the meeting of the Expert Team on Operational Climate

Prediction System (ET-OCPS), in Bologna, Italy, from 17 to

19 September 2024

Action required: To confirm your participation, with or without funding at your earliest

convenience, but preferably no later than 18 May 2024

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am pleased to inform you that the meeting of the Expert Team on Operational Climate Prediction System (ET-OCPS) will be held in Bologna, Italy, from 17 to 19 September 2024 and I invite you to the meeting as an expert listed in Annex I.

The third session of the WMO Commission for Observation, Infrastructure and Information Systems (INFCOM-3) was held in Geneva, Switzerland from 15 to 19 April 2024. At this session, INFCOM decided to establish the Standing Committee on the WMO Integrated Processing and Prediction System (SC-WIPPS) to address high priority tasks, including those aimed at supporting the Early Warnings for All initiative. These tasks will result in enhancing the predictability in sub-seasonal to decadal climate prediction and better meeting user requirements on climate prediction and climate reanalysis. These have been outlined in a workplan of SC-WIPPS for 2024–2025 and will be undertaken by its subsidiary body, ET-OCPS.

ET-OCPS is responsible for scientific and technical coordination pertinent to climate prediction with the aim of further evolving the WIPPS, including functions and products of relevant WIPPS Designated Centres. ET-OCPS will deliberate on and refine the workplan, breaking it down into action plans that emphasize the provision of newly adopted recommended climate products, and a demonstration plan for the WIPPS Rolling Review of User Requirements in climatology category, with associated timelines. ET-OCPS will also consider anticipated challenges, their mitigation measures, and the capabilities of each relevant WIPPS Designated Centre while conducting action plans. The discussions will also encompass two newly adopted WIPPS activities during INFCOM-3: global climate reanalysis and the coordination of assessment of multiple climate reanalysis, and designated centres.

Additionally, ET-OCPS will review the progress of action items made at the previous meeting in Lisbon, Portugal, held on 19 and 23 September 2022 and revise the timeline for the items, considering the difficulties encountered.

It is hoped that the participation cost in this meeting will be borne by your organization. If, however, it is not possible, WMO is prepared to consider, upon request, providing financial support which may consist of travel cost (most economic air fare according to the most direct route) and/or per diem.

For administrative purposes, I should be grateful if you could kindly confirm your participation at the earliest convenience, but preferably no later than **18 May 2024**, and indicate whether any financial and/or travel assistance will be required. If financial and/or travel assistance is required, the representative shall complete, sign, and return the enclosed
