I have the honour to inform you that the WMO/Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP) Panel on Tropical Cyclones Trust Fund (hereinafter referred to as the Fund) has been established to provide support to the Panel to facilitate the implementation of its important programmes, concerning the mitigation of the harmful effects caused by tropical cyclones, associated floods and storm surges. The Fund shall assist in the provision of institutional support to the Panel's programme, other support activities, or activities of Members related to programme objectives.

I wish to convey my sincere appreciation to the Panel members who have provided financial contributions and made pledges to contribute to the Fund.

The Fund has been established from voluntary cash contributions by members of the Panel. At the fiftieth session of the WMO/ESCAP Panel on Tropical Cyclones (PTC-50) which was held in Manama, the Kingdom of Bahrain, from 19 to 23 December 2023, the Panel urged its members to continue their contributions to the Fund as a substantial support to the Panel's activities.
