يسرني أن أبلغكم أن مرفق الأرصاد الجوية في سنغافورة (MSS) والمنظمة (WMO) سيشتركان في عقد المجموعة الثالثة من برنامج القيادة والإدارة لكبار المسؤولين في المرافق الوطنية للأرصاد الجوية والهيدرولوجيا (NMHSs)، افتراضياً على مدى أسبوعين في الفترة 3-6 والفترة 10-13 آب/ أغسطس 2021.

THIRD LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME FOR SENIOR MANAGEMENT OF NATIONAL METEOROLOGICAL AND HYDROLOGICAL SERVICES

From 3 to 6 and from 10 to 13 August 2021 (via Zoom platform)

Programme Information Brochure

Leadership and management are important skills for all National Meteorological and Hydrological Services (NMHSs). Development of these skills for Senior Management of NMHSs is critical to the attainment of organizational efficiency, financial prudence, staff motivation and in the accomplishment of organizational goals.

The *Leadership and Management Programme for Senior Management of NMHSs* aims to develop successful managers in WMO Member NMHSs. Due to the prevailing COVID-19 situation, the third run of the programme is conducted virtually over two weeks in August of this year. The programme is designed to help participants enhance their leadership and management skills through live lectures and group discussions, as well as activities to apply what they have learnt in their own organizational context.

The programme is jointly conducted by the Meteorological Service Singapore (MSS) and WMO.

1. Programme Content and Format

- 1.1 The programme aims to be engaging and intensive, with formal lectures by expert speakers, group activities and discussions, and sharing of experience.

Pre-programme Survey

- 1.2 Participants are requested to complete a simple survey two weeks prior to the start of the programme, to give the trainers a better understanding of participants' training needs and expectations. The link to the survey will be sent to successful applicants.

Virtual Programme

- 1.3 The programme will be conducted online via the Zoom platform in eight half-days (between 0530 UTC and 1000 UTC) spread over two weeks. The tentative programme schedule is attached at [Appendix A](#).
- 1.4 The programme covers the following topics:
- (i) Leadership and governance
 - (ii) Strategic foresight and planning
 - (iii) Financial management
 - (iv) Human resources development
 - (v) Strategies in communications, negotiations and international relations

- 1.5 All participants are requested to share a 5-minute presentation about their organization, the leadership and management challenges they face, and their expected outcomes from the programme.

Post-programme Activity

- 1.6 At the conclusion of the online programme, participants will work with the lead programme facilitator to apply the skills learnt to a leadership or management challenge they face in their organizations.

2. Working Language

- 2.1 The programme is conducted entirely in English. No translation service is provided.

3. Application Criteria

- 3.1 Applicants should:
 - (i) Hold senior management positions of Director-General, Director or equivalent in their NMHSs; and
 - (ii) Be proficient in written and spoken English.
- 3.2 The programme can accommodate up to 25 participants. Priority is given to applicants from Regional Associations II and V, and developing and least developed Members from other regional associations.
