Subject: Preparations for COP30, Belém, Brazil, 10-21 November 2025

Action required: Follow up on COP30 preparations through your national designated focal point to UNFCCC

Dear Sir/Madam,

This is to inform you that the 30th session of the Conference of the Parties (COP30) to the Climate Change Convention (UNFCCC) will be held in conjunction with the 20th session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP20) and the seventh meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA7) in Belém, Brazil, from 10-21 November 2025. The Conference will be preceded by the World Leaders Climate Action Summit from 6-7 November 2025.

In advance of the above-mentioned events WMO Secretariat is preparing a short paper with top-level objectives for COP30. This material and all the information about WMO involvements at COP30 will be posted on the following webpage: [WMO at COP30](#).

I am pleased to inform you that the COP30 President-designate and WMO have co-organized a COP30 briefing meeting to diplomatic missions and international organizations in Geneva, which will be held in the WMO building, on 17 September 2025.

WMO's interagency flagship initiatives, such as the Early Warning for All (EW4All) is among our key contributions to the ambition of Parties to meet the targets of the Paris Agreement. These also contribute to the COP30 presidency initiatives on mitigation and adaptation.

During COP30, WMO and its co-sponsored bodies, namely, IPCC, GCOS and WCRP will have an active role in the mandated event of the Earth Information Day, which provides the latest scientific information for Parties at COP. WMO will lead a UN System side event titled "Weather, Water and Climate Information for a Resilient Future" along with five partners, UNDRR, IOC/UNESCO, UNDP, FAO and WIPO.

Following successful experience from the previous years, WMO, IPCC and MERI Foundation (Chile) will join forces to organize a Pavilion titled "Science for Climate Action", at COP30 to provide a hub for delegates from NMHSs, IPCC and affiliated communities to meet and discuss relevant thematic topics of the COP30 daily programme and negotiation tracks.

I would recommend that the Permanent Representatives with WMO continue to initiate active interaction with the designated focal points of UNFCCC and national delegations in their respective countries to ensure an enhanced level of contributions from the WMO community and NMHSs to UNFCCC and the Paris Agreement processes.
