I refer to the Executive Council Decision 8 (EC-75) - Concept note on the Consortium of WMO Education and Training Collaborating Partners, held in 2022, regarding the endorsement of the Consortium of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) Education and Training Collaborating Partners (CONECT). To ensure effective implementation of the decision, the first meeting of CONECT is scheduled to take place in Geneva, 17–21 April 2023.
