Following the successful launch of the Provisional State of the Climate 2022 at COP27, I am pleased to announce the launch of the content preparation process of the final report, which will be published in March/April 2023.

The Secretariat has developed a dedicated online data collection platform for extreme and high impact events. The platform serves as a single entry-point for both Global and Regional State of the Climate in 2022. This will ease sharing information on high impact events, adequate geo-localization of the events, quality control and updates.
