Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to inform you that the Executive Council of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO), at its sixty-sixth session which was held in Geneva from 18 to 27 June 2014, decided that its sixty-seventh session would be held in Geneva from 15 to 17 June 2015 after the closure of the Seventeenth World Meteorological Congress (Geneva, 25 May-12 June 2015).

This notification is being sent to all Members of the Organization because at the present time the full composition of the Executive Council for the sixty-seventh session is not known and will be established through the elections, which will be held during the Seventeenth World Meteorological Congress, with the exception of the presidents of the six regional associations, who as ex officio members of the Executive Council are elected by their respective Association and invited to the sixty-seventh session of the Executive Council.

I should be greatly obliged if you would kindly take appropriate steps so that the Permanent Representative of your country with WMO may take part in the sixty-seventh session of the Executive Council if he/she should be elected a member of the Council or if, being a president of a regional association, he/she is already a member.

Relevant information pertaining to the composition and functioning of the Executive Council are found in Articles 13 to 17 and Regulations 141 to 161 of the WMO General Regulations.

The Provisional Annotated Agenda of the session will be made available in due time.

A copy of this letter is being sent to the Permanent Representative of Members with the World Meteorological Organization.
