I have the honour to inform you that Phase I of the nineteenth session of Regional Association V (South-West Pacific) (RA V-19), of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) will be held online from 9 to 11 September 2025.

Regulation 20 of the WMO General Regulations (*Basic documents No. 1*, (WMO-No. 15)) requests Members to provide credentials for their delegations for the session with a clear indication of the principal delegate. I should welcome in due course the credentials of your delegation, signed by, or on behalf of, an appropriate governmental authority of the Member.

In view of their official status with WMO, Permanent Representatives are kindly invited to act as focal points for the online registration of their delegation to RA V-19. The link to the online [Event Registration System \(ERS\)](#), the username and password that were sent to the Permanent Representatives by email, remain valid for all upcoming WMO meetings.

Please also note that the submission of information through the online ERS does not exempt Members from the need to provide valid credentials for the participating delegation.

In view of the limited time during this session to discuss documents, Permanent Representatives and session delegates are invited to provide their comments and proposed changes to the documents in advance of the session via plenary@wmo.int, preferably one week before the session. Elections of RA V officers (president and vice-president) are constitutionally due to be held during Phase I of the session based on the provisions of General **Regulations 10** and **62** (*Basic documents No. 1*, (WMO-No. 15)). Taking into account the online nature of the session, voting if required, will be undertaken through a real-time, confidential email vote. Details on the elections and on conducting a vote if required, will be accessible on the session website.
