You may recall that the Sixteenth World Meteorological Congress (Cg-XVI) in 2011 requested the Executive Council (EC) and the Secretary-General to continue with further development and implementation of the WMO Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) System, which included precise definition and correct application of the System.

To implement the request of Cg-XVI, the WMO Secretariat has developed two documents, namely: (a) the WMO Monitoring and Evaluation Guide (WMO-No. 1088, April 2012); and (b) the WMO M&E System (WMO-No. 1089, April 2012). The Secretariat has also developed the WMO Risk Management Framework (WMO-No. 1111) to guide the implementation of WMO Risk Management Policy approved by the sixty-third session of the EC through its Resolution 12 (EC-LXIII).
