Dear Sir/Madam,

In March of this year, we will once again celebrate World Meteorological Day to commemorate the coming into force on 23 March 1950 of the Convention establishing WMO. As you will recall, the WMO Executive Council decided that the theme for 2014 will be "Weather and climate: Engaging youth".

Our 2014 theme recognizes that the youth of today will benefit enormously from the dramatic advances being made in our ability to understand and forecast the Earth's weather and climate. It also acknowledges growing concerns about human-induced climate change. Most of today's children and youth will see the second half of this century, when many of the serious impacts predicted by the WMO/UNEP Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change are expected to occur. It is vital that the WMO community engage children and youth in both understanding and responding to global warming.

The WMO Secretariat is preparing materials to assist you in organizing the World Meteorological Day celebration. We have started to make these materials available on the WMO website. We will also be pleased to post on the website information that you send to us about your national celebration in an official language of the Organization (Arabic, Chinese, English, Russian, French, and Spanish).
