Dear Sir/Madam,

The 30th session of the Conference of the Parties (COP30) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) will be held in Belém, Brazil, from 10 to 21 November 2025. This landmark meeting will gather Heads of State and Government, ministers, technical experts, and representatives from civil society, academia, and the private sector to advance collective action towards the goals of the Paris Agreement.

As Secretary-General of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO), I will be in Belém from 6 to 12 November 2025 to participate in the World Leaders Climate Action Summit, which will open COP30 and provide a platform for Heads of State and Government to present enhanced commitments and actions to accelerate the global response to climate change and I will participate in the 30th session of the Conference of the Parties (COP30).

WMO will actively contribute to COP30 through a series of high-level and technical events, in collaboration with our partners across the United Nations system and the global hydrometeorological and scientific community. These engagements will underscore WMO's key role in advancing science-based decision-making, strengthening early warning systems, and supporting adaptation and resilience-building worldwide.
