A global summary statement will be released in November 2024 at the twenty-ninth session of the Conference of the Parties (COP29). The final WMO State of the Global Climate report will be published in March/April 2025.

The Climate Monitoring and Policy Services Division (CMP) has developed a dedicated online data collection platform for extreme and high-impact events, which serves as a single entry point for both the global and regional State of the Climate in 2024 to facilitate sharing information on high-impact events, an adequate geolocation of the events, quality control and updates. It would be appreciated if you could complete this survey by **30 September 2024.** You are further invited to update your contributions for 2024 after this deadline (but **not later than 15 January 2025**).
