Further to the letter No. 5132-22/IPCC/AR6 of 15 February 2022, I am addressing you on the changes to the schedule of the Synthesis Report (SYR) of the Sixth Assessment Report.

Following consultation with the Bureau, the Panel has approved the change to the Core Writing Team 3 (CWT-3) to be postponed from 4-8 April 2022 to 25-29 April 2022.

With regards to the review period of the SYR Final Government Distribution (FGD) initially proposed to be shortened from eight weeks to six weeks (27 June to 7 August 2022), following comments received by some Member countries on their preference for the review period to be shortened from eight weeks to seven weeks instead of six weeks and after further consideration with the Authors, please be informed that the review period for the SYR Final Government Distribution will be shortened from eight weeks to seven weeks (20 June to 7 August 2022).

We would like to thank you for your positive feedback and continued support.
