Subject: IPCC Working Group II contribution to the Sixth Assessment Report

Dear Sir/Madam,

You may recall that at the 41st Session of the IPCC (Nairobi, Kenya, 24-27 February 2015), the Panel agreed to prepare a Sixth Assessment Report (AR6). Following a Scoping meeting in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, in May 2017, the <u>outline</u> of the Working Group II contribution to the AR6 was approved at the 11th Session of Working Group II and adopted at the 46th Session of the IPCC, both meetings took place in Montreal, Canada, in September 2017. The Panel also decided that the Working Group II contribution to the AR6 would be completed in October 2021, with the completion of the Working Group I and Working Group III contribution to the AR6 in 2021 as well, and the Synthesis Report following in the course of 2022.

I have the honour to inform you of the availability of the First Order Draft (FOD) of this report. According to IPCC procedures for preparing IPCC reports, "the first draft reports should be sent to Government Focal Points, for information". The IPCC issued an open call for registration to join the Expert Review on 11 October 2019. In addition, the announcement was sent directly to all nominees for the preparation of the WG II contribution to the AR6 who were not selected as authors or review editors.
