The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change at its 60<sup>th</sup> Session (IPCC-60) per <u>Decision IPCC-LX-7</u>, set up an Ad-Hoc Group with the **mandate** to advise governments on the way forward in considering the Lessons Learned from the sixth assessment cycle, including but not limited to those identified in Annex 1 of the document <u>IPCC-LX/INF. 9</u>.

The Ad-Hoc Group will work intersessionally with the view to report back to the Panel for consideration at its Sixty-first Session, scheduled to take place tentatively end of July 2024.

Upon constitution of the Ad-Hoc Group noting <u>Decision IPCC-LX-7</u>, it was agreed that the United States of America and South Africa would serve as Co-Chairs. Please be informed that Ms Brittany Croll (United States of America) and Ms Debra Roberts (South Africa) have been designated by their respective governments as Co-Chairs of the Ad-Hoc Group.

Please be informed that the first meeting of the Ad-Hoc Group will be held on 27 March 2024 in virtual format.
