You may recall that the Panel, at its Forty-third Session (Nairobi, Kenya, 11–13 April 2016) in its decision on the products of the sixth assessment cycle, decided that the seventh assessment cycle would include a Special Report on Climate Change and Cities.

The IPCC issued an open call for registration to join the Expert Review on 17 September 2025. In addition, the announcement was sent directly to all nominees for the preparation of the Special Report who were not selected as authors or review editors.
