You may recall that the Panel, at its Sixtieth Session of the IPCC (Istanbul, Türkiye, 16–19 January 2026), decided to prepare a Seventh Assessment Report (AR7).

Following a Scoping meeting in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, in December 2024, the [outline](#) of the Working Group I (WGI) contribution to the AR7 was approved at the Fifteenth Session of Working Group I and adopted at the Sixty-Second Session of the IPCC, both of which took place in Hangzhou, China, in February 2025.

I have the honour to inform you of the availability of the First Order Draft (FOD) of this report. The draft report is accessible via the IPCC website at: *[Part of the text removed here]*. Please login using your IPCC credentials. **This draft is provided on a confidential basis in accordance with IPCC procedures and must not be distributed, cited or quoted.** Access credentials must not be shared. Participation in the review requires separate registration through the IPCC review system.

According to IPCC procedures for preparing IPCC reports, "the first draft reports should be sent to Government Focal Points, for information". The IPCC issued an open call for registration to join the Expert Review on Monday 6 July 2026. In addition, the announcement was sent directly to all nominees for the preparation of the WGI contribution to the AR7 who were not selected as authors or review editors.
