I am pleased to inform you that, at the kind invitation of the Government of Cabo Verde. the Sixteenth Regional Technical Conference on Regional Association 1 (RA I-Africa) will be held in Praia, Cabo Verde, from 6 to 7 October 2014 to be followed by the sixteenth session of RA I (RA I-16) from 8 to 14 October 2014. The purpose of the Technical Conference is to provide a forum for NMHSs Directors and senior officials to exchange views and share experiences on challenges and emerging issues that Members are facing and identify future regional priorities to improve weather, climate and water services for sustainable development. The outcomes of the Conference will be reported to RA I-16.
