Nomination of candidate for vice-president of Regional Association II

Action required:

Nomination of a candidate for the position of vice-president of

Regional Association II by 2 October 2019

Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish to inform you that, following the departure of Mr Rishi Ram Sharma, former Director-General, Department of Hydrology and Meteorology and Permanent Representative of Nepal with the World Meteorological Organization (WMO), the position of vice-president of Regional Association II (Asia) became vacant as Mr Sharma subsequently ceased to hold the office of the position of vice-president of the Region in accordance with Regulation 10 of the General Regulations, as provided in Basic Documents No. 1: 2015 Edition.

Following consultations with the Members of the Region, Mr Abdullah Ahmed Al-Mandoos, president of Regional Association II, advised the Secretariat that Associate Professor Dr Tran Hong Thai, Administrator of Viet Nam Meteorological and Hydrological Administration and Permanent Representative of Viet Nam with WMO, has received support from the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment for the position of vice-president of Regional Association II and is therefore designated as a candidate on the list of nominees.

Since the procedure for an election by correspondence is necessary, the president of Regional Association II agreed to proceed with the election in accordance with the provision of Regulation 15 of the General Regulations.

I therefore invite you to consider further nominations, if you so wish, for candidates to this office, in compliance with Regulation 92 of the General Regulations, which stipulates that:

When it is decided to hold elections by correspondence, the Secretary-General shall invite those entitled to vote to nominate in advance eligible candidates for the office or place to be filled. The president who requested the election shall decide on the duration of the period, which shall not be less than 30 days, during which nominations of candidates will be received.

In the determination of those who are entitled to vote and make nominations, the following provisions of the General Regulations, as well as decisions of Congress, should be taken into account:

(a) Regulation 168(a) prescribes that the president and vice-president of an Association shall be Directors of Meteorological or Hydrometeorological Services of Members of the Organization belonging to the Region, as specified by Regulation 141. In this connection, Regulation 141 stipulates that a Member, which belongs to more than one regional association shall, for the purposes of Article 13 of the Convention, normally be regarded as coming from the Region in which the headquarters of its Meteorological Service is located;

- (b) Regulation 8 stipulates that 'Except as provided by Article 4(b) of the Convention, no person shall be entitled to act at the same time as president or vice-president of more than one of the constituent bodies, or as president of a constituent body and an elected member of the Executive Council';
- (c) By its Resolution 37 (Cg-XI), the Eleventh Congress decided, inter alia, that nationals or representatives of a Member in arrears for more than two consecutive calendar years shall not be eligible for nomination for elective offices of constituent bodies.

To assist the Members in nominating candidates, I enclose a list of eligible Directors of the Meteorological or Hydrometeorological Services as of the date of this letter according to the information available in the Secretariat (Annex).

After receiving nominations, I shall obtain confirmation of the nominees' availability, in accordance with Regulation 93. This regulation further provides that when the list of candidates only contains one name, this candidate shall be declared elected.

In accordance with Regulation 92, the president of RA II has decided that a period of 30 days shall be allowed for receipt of nominations. I should be grateful if you would send me any nomination you wish to make for the office of the vice-president of RA II, as soon as possible, and no later than **2 October 2019**.
