The Conference will start at 13h00 on 11 September 2014.

Registration of participants

The Conference will be conducted in English and Spanish.

Currency

Most businesses, tour operators, airlines and hotels accept major credit cards and traveler's cheques. Only US dollars and euros are easily exchanged into local currency. The average exchange rate in January 2014 was as follows:
