As you are aware, the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) Regional Association V (RA V) called for the biennial session of the RA V Tropical Cyclone Committee (RA V TCC) for the South Pacific and South-East Indian Ocean ([Resolution 15 \(RA V-17\)](#) - Regional Association V Tropical Cyclone Committee for the South Pacific and South-East Indian Ocean, (Nuku'alofa, Tonga 15–17 October 2018)).

However, recognizing a much compressed RA V TCC session was held in 2020 due to the worldwide pandemic of COVID-19, and the previous desire of the Committee for annual meetings, after consultation with the Chair of RA V TCC, it has been decided to conduct a longer session in 2021.
