I would like to inform you that the Regional Training Center of the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) will be conducting a Hydrologists Training Course that aims to provide general operational hydrology knowledge with a particular focus on hydrological forecasting. In continuation of the fruitful cooperation between WMO and PAGASA on fellowships activities, the course, including two months on-the-job training, will be held in PAGASA from July 2013 until June 2014 in partnership with WMO.

As a course requirement, applicants should have either completed PAGASA's Meteorologist Training Course, or should have graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree in Engineering or other allied sciences.

PAGASA will provide the accommodation for the entire duration of the course to selected foreign participants from RA V. The tuition fee will also be waived and local transportation will be provided by the agency during its conduct of the on-the-job training.
