Subject: Invitation to the RA VI Training Workshop on Incident Management System to be held on 14 May and 4 June 2024 (online)

Action required: To register the workshop participants by 13 May 2024

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am pleased to inform you that the WMO is organizing an online RA VI Training Workshop on Incident Management System (IMS) on 14 May and 4 June 2024. The workshop's primary target audience is the National Focal Points for WMO Integrated Global Observing System (WIGOS) Data Quality Monitoring System (WDQMS) as well as staff from Regional WIGOS Centre (RWC) candidate Members in RA VI. The workshop will be organized in two parts as follows:

1. Initial technical session regarding accessing the IMS on **14 May 2024 at 9:30-11:30 CEST**
2. Training on IMS with examples and exercises for creating and managing tickets based on issues identified with the WDQMS webtool on **4 June at 9:30-12:30 CEST**

The Incident Management System (IMS) is utilized by the RWCs to perform one of their mandatory functions: registration and follow-up of observational issues identified in the quality evaluation process. IMS can be accessed by registered users from the RWCs and NFPs for WDQMS. The NFPs for WDQMS coordinate the interaction with RWCs including providing timely answers to all queries and tickets in the context of WDQMS. The detailed programme will be communicated to the registered participants.

Therefore, I kindly remind of the need to nominate the NFPs for WDQMS, if not already done so. Kindly refer to the WMO letter with reference number [26294/2019/OBS/WIGOS/WDQMS](#) dated 24 October 2019. This is essential for utilization of the IMS and for the work of the RWCs in RA VI, whose activities are expected to commence on 24 June 2024. The nominations can be done through the WMO Community Platform. For your kind information, the annex provides the list of currently nominated NFPs for WDQMS.
