Tengo el placer de informarle que el Centro regional de formación (CRF) de Bet Dagan, en colaboración con la Agencia Israelí de Cooperación Internacional para el Desarrollo (MASHAV) y con algunos conferenciantes, incluidos conferenciantes de la Oficina Meteorológica del Reino Unido, organizará un Cursillo de formación sobre “Evaluación de las competencias de predictores y observadores aeronáuticos” en Shefayim, Israel, del 29 de octubre al 2 de noviembre de 2012.

El Cursillo tiene por objeto proporcionar orientación sobre la evaluación de las competencias del personal de meteorología aeronáutica, de conformidad con el kit de evaluación de las competencias de la CMAe de la OMM y con la Resolución 53 (CG-XVI). El Cursillo está destinado a ayudar a los Miembros a construir un sistema de gestión de las competencias antes de noviembre de 2013 (antes de que la norma pase a ser obligatoria). El Cursillo se impartirá en inglés.

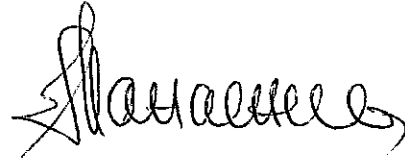
El Gobierno de Israel ofrecerá becas, que sufragarán los gastos de alojamiento en régimen de pensión completa (habitación ocupada por dos personas) para toda la duración del Cursillo, derechos de matrícula y transporte para los participantes de países en desarrollo. Sin embargo, la beca no cubre los gastos del pasaje por vía aérea hacia o desde Israel ni el dinero para gastos personales. Se dispondrá de un número limitado de subsidios de viaje por vía aérea para los participantes. Workshop on Competence Assessment of Aviation Forecasters and Observers

**Shefayim, Israel
29 October – 2 November 2012**

1. Introduction

The IMS/WMO RTC Bet Dagan of the Israel Meteorological Service has provided training at post-graduate level since 1967. Several thousand participants from all over the world, mainly from developing countries, took advantage of the opportunities provided by our RTC to study the application of meteorology to various aspects of economic activity.

2. Competence Assessment Requirements

At its sixteenth session, on May 2011, the World Meteorological Congress approved the inclusion of Competency Standards for Aeronautical Meteorological Personnel into WMO Technical Regulation No. 49, Volume I. The Competency Standards have been developed and endorsed by the WMO Commission for Aeronautical Meteorology (CAeM) in response to the ICAO Annex 3, 2.1.5 requirement.

The Congress Resolution means that all providers of aeronautical meteorological services shall be able to demonstrate by 1 December 2013 that their professional personnel satisfy these Competency Standards. Compliance with the Competency Standards is an integral part of the ICAO Concept of Quality Management System and hence must be documented and recorded.

Thus all meteorological authorities and service providers have to construct and apply (before the December 2013 deadline) competency assessment methodology for their professional personnel providing services to aviation. WMO CAeM Expert Team on Education, Training and Competencies (ET/ETC) (formerly the Task Team for the Development of the Competency Assessment Toolkit, TT-CAT) has developed a best practice guidance on how Members can assess these competencies.

3. Workshop Objectives

The workshop aims at providing guidance to Competence Assessment of Aeronautical Meteorological Personnel, in line with the CAeM Competence Assessment toolkit (CAT) and within the framework of the ICAO Concept of Quality Management System.

4. Main Workshop Content

The workshop's curriculum will include a combination of classroom lectures, discussions, exercises and demonstrations. The following topics will be discussed:

- Competence Assessment as an integral part of the Quality Management System and the Safety Management System.
- Response to failures to perform competently. Restoring and developing competencies.
- The WMO/CAeM Competence Standards.
- Various assessment tools, their pro's and con's.
- Best practices in building and utilizing various assessment tools.
- Assessment during the OJT period.
- Challenges in assessment of experienced staff.
- Routine performance monitoring as part of a Competency Management System.
- The WMO/CAeM Competency Assessment Toolkit.
- Building a national Competence Management System of Aeronautical Meteorological Personnel.

5. Participation cost

- The airfare cost should be covered by the participant, by his/her employer, or by a granting institution.
- The total cost of lodging at full board for single in a double room during the duration of the workshop, including tuition fees and transportation will amount to app. 90\$ per day (inc. insurance). Total for the whole period is 540\$

6. Scholarships

- Scholarships, covering the expenses of lodging at full board (two persons sharing a room) during the duration of the workshop, tuition fees and transportation will be provided by the Government of Israel – MASHAV – Israel's Agency for International Development Cooperation - for applicants from developing countries.
- The above scholarship, however, does not cover airfare expenses to and from Israel or per diem (pocket money).
- A limited number of air travel grants may be available from WMO and from MASHAV.

7. Criteria

The Workshop will be most beneficial to operational aeronautical forecasting managers and trainers and especially to those who are to be appointed as assessors.

8. Language

The workshop will be held in **English**. A working knowledge of English is mandatory.

9. Training Staff

The workshop will be conducted by members of the CAeM/ Expert Team on Education, Training and Competencies (ET/ETC). Invited guest lecturers, including lecturers from the UK Met Office, will also participate in providing and sharing their knowledge and experience in specific fields of expertise.

10. Registration
