Enrolment Information

Leadership and management are important skills for all National Meteorological and Hydrological Services (NMHSs). Development of these skills for Senior Management of NMHSs is critical to the attainment of organizational efficiency, financial prudence, staff motivation and in accomplishment of organizational goals.

The *Leadership and Management Programme for Senior Management of NMHSs* aims to develop successful managers in WMO Member NMHSs. The programme is designed to help participants enhance their leadership and management skills through lectures and group discussions.

The programme is jointly conducted by the Meteorological Service Singapore (MSS) and the World Meteorological Organization (WMO).

1. Programme Content and Format

- 1.1 The programme will be held as an in-person event in Singapore over 5 days from 4 to 8 September 2023. The tentative programme schedule is attached at Appendix A.
- 1.2 The programme covers the following topics:
 - (i) Policy development and strategic management
 - (ii) Institutional development
 - (iii) Communication, partnership, and engagement
 - (iv) Capacity development and human resources
 - (v) Resource mobilization and financing
- 1.3 Participants will have the opportunity to share their leadership and management experiences they face in their respective organisations during the programme.
- 1.4 The programme is conducted entirely in English. No translation service is provided.

2. Application Criteria

2.1 Applicants should:

- (i) Hold senior management positions of Director-General, Director or equivalent in their NMHSs.
- (ii) Be proficient in written and spoken English; and
- (iii) In good health.

2.2 The programme can accommodate up to 20 participants. Priority will be given to applicants from Regional Associations (RA) II and V and developing and least developed member countries from other RAs.

3. Application Procedure

3.1 Please complete and submit the following documents to MSS_PIA@nea.gov.sg, with copy to tra@wmo.int:

- (i) Application Form attached at [Appendix B](#); and
- (ii) A 1-page curriculum vitae (CV).

3.2 The closing date for application is **Monday, 17 July 2023**.

4. Sponsorship

4.1 Co-sponsorship by MSS and WMO will be available for participants from developing and least developed countries. One participant is eligible for sponsorship from each country. The sponsorship will include the following:

- (i) One Economy Class round-trip air ticket
- (ii) Accommodation for the duration of the programme in Singapore
- (iii) Per diem
- (iv) Airport transfer; and
- (v) Local transport, where necessary.

4.2 Please note that:

- (i) Participants are encouraged to purchase insurance for their own coverage purposes. The organiser will not be responsible for any accident, illness, loss, or damage which may occur during the organisation of the event.
- (ii) Participants are to bear their personal miscellaneous expenses that might be incurred prior to receiving the per diem.

- (iii) Any expenses for out-patient medical/dental treatment will be borne by the participants themselves.
