J'ai le plaisir de vous informer que l'Administration météorologique nationale roumaine (Meteo Romania) accueillera le cours de l'Organisation météorologique mondiale (OMM) destiné aux formateurs en milieu opérationnel et aux évaluateurs des compétences de la Région VI du 25 au 29 juillet 2022, à Bucarest, Roumanie.

Ce cours sera axé sur le développement des capacités par l'application des compétences, en utilisant des outils propres à la formation en cours d'emploi et à l'évaluation des compétences. Il abordera les informations et les compétences pouvant être appliquées et adaptées à toutes les activités opérationnelles des Services météorologiques et hydrologiques nationaux (SMHN). Cette formation est proposée par l'OMM au titre de son objectif global de développement des capacités au sein des SMHN. Il s'agit notamment de réduire l'écart entre la théorie et la pratique afin de garantir une application adaptée et pérenne des compétences requises en milieu opérationnel. Le cours se déroulera en anglais et vous trouverez des informations complémentaires à l'annexe I. Tous les renseignements utiles, ainsi que le programme provisoire du cours, seront communiqués ultérieurement aux candidats sélectionnés.

**WMO Course for On-the-Job Trainers and Competency Assessors**

**25-29 July 2022, Bucharest, Romania**

**Course Information**

**Overview:**

The World Meteorological Organization (WMO) course for On-the-Job Trainers (OJT) and Competency Assessors (CA) will be offered by the WMO and hosted by Romanian National Meteorological Administration (MeteoRomania), in Bucharest, Romania, between 25 and 29 July 2022.

The concept of competency is directly connected to the activities of individuals and must be very well understood and correctly implemented. Hence, as a result of the need to improve on the situation, the issue arose during the Fourteenth WMO Symposium on Education and Training (SYMET-14), following which the participants emphasised the need to fill the gap between theory and practice, especially with respect to real-life application.

The course will focus especially on examples of how these are utilised in the operational environment. One of the premises of the course is that training is enriched by practical applications, and the achieved skills can be adapted to create coherence in the approach to competency implementation not only in different operational activities in NMHS but also between NMHSs in the Region.

**Objectives:**

After participating in this course, participants will have enhanced their skills to contribute to the development of the competencies identified in the WMO Competency Requirements for Education and Training Providers for Meteorological, Hydrological, and Climate Services, as approved by EC-65 and as described in the 2016 revision to WMO Technical Regulations, No. 49, Volume 1.

**Course Content:**

The WMO Course for OJT and CA is designed to be practical and highly active. It will include many short readings but even more opportunities for interaction with facilitators and fellow participants. A note containing general information for participants and the provisional programme schedule will be distributed to selected candidates in due course.

**Learning Outcomes:**

At the end of the course, trainees will be able to:

- deliver training on implementation of OJT and CA, as a general approach, at the organisation level as a component of capacity development and advise on adaption to different fields of activity in NMHSs;
- guide and support NMHSs in competency implementation regarding OJT and CA for different areas of activity.

- apply OJT techniques to specific activities in NMHSs by adapting the acquired competencies.
- apply competency assessment.

Since the proposed training program focuses on OJT and CA's principles and not on a specific specialisation, the outcomes of the training program are wide enough to cover all sections of an NMHS and the adaption to different fields of activity can be facilitated.

Using the described concept, therefore, the following benefits will emerge:

- More coherent competency approach among Members considering similar OJT and CA implementation.
- Opportunity to create a broad image in the NMHSs on the level of competencies of staff and individual and group development needs.
- Quicker delivery of information and a more structured way of sharing experiences.
- More efficient use of human and financial resources.
- Enhancement of the capacity of WMO RTCs (Regional Training Centres) and NMHS training institutions to support capacity development endeavours.
- Support implementation of WMO reform at the regional level with an attending benefit to Members.

#### **Profile of Participants:**

The profile of the participants should be deeply connected with the operational environment and is proposed as follows:

- Willingness to share skills, knowledge, and expertise
- Availability of deployment to deliver courses in OJT and CA
- Versatility and enthusiasm in providing information
- Originating from operational environment and with strong operational experience
- Some experience in delivering on-the-job training and previous attendance to a Train-the-Trainers course will be an advantage
- Good English language skills

Please note that while we encourage WMO Members to cover the expenses of their participants to attend the course, WMO is prepared to support one participant each from selected WMO Members if requested by the Permanent Representative.
