Уважаемый господин/Уважаемая госпожа,

Рада сообщить Вам о том, что Китайская Народная Республика будет проводить международный учебный курс по теме «Прогнозирование тропических циклонов» в период с 14 по 25 октября 2013 г. в Региональном учебном центре ВМО (РУЦ) в Нанкине, Китай.

Курс предназначен для метеорологов, в основном из развивающихся стран, которые работают в области прогнозирования погоды и других смежных областях. Курс будет проводиться на английском языке. Он будет охватывать, главным образом, теоретические основы и методики прогнозирования тропических циклонов. Данный курс будет полезен в плане повышения квалификации слушателей курса в обеспечении прогнозирования явлений погоды со значительными последствиями, связанных с тропическими циклонами, проведении научных исследований, а также в вопросах организации работ.

Китайское правительство покроет расходы, связанные с обучением, и может предоставить, по запросу, поддержку в месте проведения данного учебного курса для принятых участников. Дополнительная информация содержится в прилагаемых к настоящему письму «Enrollment Information» (Информация о порядке зачисления) и «Application Form» (Бланк заявки на участие в курсе).

Назначенным кандидатам предлагается заполнить прилагаемый бланк «Application Form», который должен быть подписан постоянным представителем соответствующей страны при ВМО, и вернуть его **не позднее 13 сентября 2013 г. непосредственно в РУЦ в Нанкине, Китай**, по адресу, указанному на бланке «Application Form».

## ENROLMENT INFORMATION

### International Training Course on Tropical Cyclone Forecast

The International Training Course on Tropical Cyclone Forecast is organized by WMO Regional Training Centre (RTC) Nanjing, and sponsored by the China Meteorological Administration (CMA).

#### 1. Objectives

Through theoretical study and practice, participants will be able to master the basic theory and principles of tropical cyclones. This will be helpful to improve participants' ability in carrying out the operation of forecasting of high-impact weather associated with tropical cyclones, scientific research as well as management.

#### 2. Date and Venue

14-25 October 2013, WMO Regional Training Centre (RTC), Nanjing, China.

#### 3. Course Contents

The training course will mainly cover lectures on tropical cyclone (TC) structure, cyclogenesis, intensity change and motion, tropical cyclone and climate change, track and structure forecasts of tropical cyclones, seasonal forecasts of tropical cyclone activity, application of satellite data and radar data in early warning of TC, societal and economic impacts of tropical cyclones and disaster mitigation and study tour to the 5th Shanghai International Disaster Reduction and Security Show (SIDRS 2013).

#### 4. Training Format

Lectures, practical sessions, seminar on special topics, study tour, discussion, and presentation.

#### 5. Language of Instruction

The course will be conducted in English.

#### 6. Targeted Trainees

Meteorologists who are working in the field of weather forecasting and other related fields mainly from developing countries.

#### 7. Required Qualifications of Participants for Admission

- a) To be specialized in weather forecasting with a minimum of one year professional experience;
- b) To be in good physical health with no infectious diseases. Physically fit to fulfill all course activities; candidates with limited physical mobility will not be accepted;
- c) To be proficient in English;
- d) To prepare a report on weather forecasting of the participants' Service and a brief introduction of the participant's professional experiences for the purpose of exchanges;
- e) Not to bring family members to the training course in principle, if bringing a family member, the participant has to pay extra expense;
- f) To observe all the laws, rules and regulations of People's Republic of China and respect the Chinese customs during the training period.

#### 8. Application and Admission

- a) The applicants must be meteorologists who are working in the field of weather forecasting from Meteorological and Hydrological Services of developing countries. The nominated candidates are requested to submit the Application Forms together with evidence of English proficiency to the WMO RTC Nanjing China for examination and endorsement.

- b) Admission Notices will be issued to the accepted participants by e-mail by the RTC Nanjing. With the Admission Notices, the participants are requested to go through all the necessary formalities for entering China and bring all the documents (Admission Notices, Application Forms) to the WMO RTC Nanjing China on the registration date of 13 October 2013.
- c) **Only accepted applicants** that receive the Admission Notices endorsed by the WMO RTC Nanjing China can participate in the training course.

#### **9. Training Expenses**

- a) Tuition fee is free for all the accepted participants that receive the endorsed Admission Notices by the WMO RTC Nanjing China.
- b) Due to limited funds, the WMO RTC Nanjing China can provide local support such as accommodation, meals, and pocket money (50 Yuan RMB per day) etc. for 20 participants only. Normally one applicant from each developing country or two applicants from each Least Developed Country are endorsed by the WMO RTC Nanjing China for the local support.
- c) Other accepted applicants or their respective governments need to cover their accommodation (50 USD per day per person) and meals (20 USD per day per person) during the training period.
- d) The international travel costs including round trip tickets, transit fares and subsistence allowance during the travel are to be covered by the participants or their employers.
- e) The expenses of visa, medical care, insurances and domestic salaries for the participants should be borne by the participants' employers.

#### **10. Insurance**

The organizer of the Training Course on Tropical Cyclone Forecast does not hold any responsibility for such risks as loss of life, accidents, illness, and loss of property incurred during the whole period of participation in the training course.
