Рад сообщить Вам о том, что по любезном приглашению правительства Республики Кореи второй Региональный практический семинар ВМО/КМА по теме «Прогнозы с учетом воздействий в Азии» будет проводиться в Корейской метеорологической администрации (КМА), Сеул, Республика Корея, с 19 по 21 ноября 2018 г.

Цели семинара состоят в том, чтобы повысить потенциал национальных метеорологических и гидрологических служб (НМГС) в области предоставления обслуживания прогнозами и предупреждениями с учетом воздействий для улучшения принятия решений, а также в том, чтобы осуществить обмен опытом и передовыми практиками для успешного внедрения обслуживания прогнозами многих опасных явлений с учетом воздействий и предупреждениями с учетом рисков.

В семинаре будут, в частности, рассматриваться темы, связанные с прогностическим обслуживанием с учетом воздействий, включая текущее положение дел в области внедрения прогнозирования с учетом воздействий и использования соответствующих технологий в каждой стране; состояние системы заблаговременного предупреждения о многих опасных явлениях и ее будущее; системы сотрудничества с соответствующими организациями и коммуникационные навыки; навыки, связанные с прогнозированием волн тепла с учетом воздействий; а также методы калибровки для прогнозирования с учетом воздействий и методы расчета вероятности рисков.



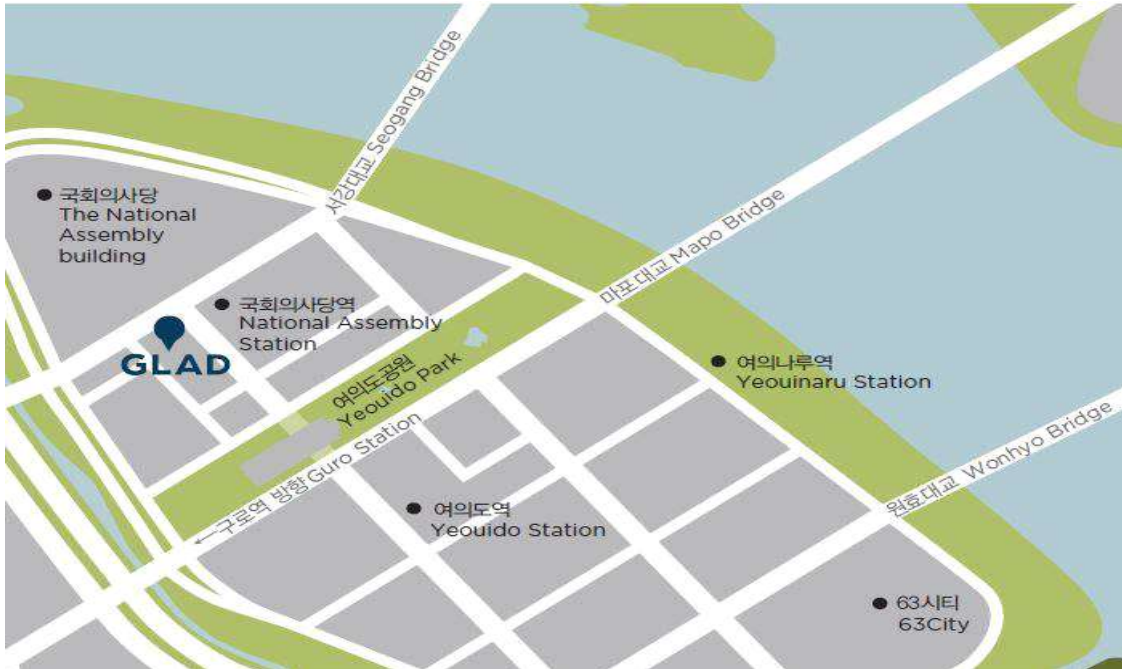
