主题: 数据浮标合作专家组关于印度洋天气预报和气候预测所用海洋观测培训研习会
(2024年8月6-8日)要求采取的行动: 于**2024年4月30日**(含)前提名贵国参会人员

尊敬的先生/女士,

WMO-IOC 联合数据浮标合作专家组(DBCP)是世界气象组织(WMO)和联合国教育、科学及文化组织(UNESCO)政府间海洋学委员会(IOC)设立的正式机构,也是全球海洋观测系统(GOOS)协调下的13个全球海洋观测网络之一。DBCP的工作重点是对漂流和系泊浮标、冰浮标和海啸浮标进行全球协调,为天气和气候应用提供数据。

在2023年10月于印度尼西亚巴厘举行的第三十九届会议(DBCP-39)上,DBCP注意到其在2016-2023年期间举办的区域培训研习会不断取得成功,并核准支持在2024年举办“天气预报和气候预测所用海洋观测培训研习会-印度洋”。

研习会旨在加强天气预报和气候预测所用的印度洋和西太平洋海洋观测。研习会的主题包括海洋数据的需求、获取和管理、在预报和气候预测中的应用以及区域要求与合作。

本研习会的主要对象是来自印度洋、印度尼西亚贯穿流和西太平洋区域,特别是来自发展中国家和地区的海洋预报员、海洋数据管理员和观测仪器操作员。研习会将仅以英语进行。随函附上研习会的目标(附件一),供参考。研习会相关计划、当地安排(住宿、签证等)和其他信息将适时在 [GOOS 活动网页](#)上公布。学员将来自国际海洋界的各个领域。

应印度尼西亚共和国气象、气候和地球物理局(BMKG)的盛情邀请,研习会将以混合会议形式于2024年8月6至8日在印度尼西亚共和国 Citeko 举行。

我鼓励您使用随附的提名/登记表(附件二)提名潜在学员。研习会将是参会者学习新技能、为主要国际计划作出重大和持续贡献的难得机会。请注意,IOC/UNESCO也发出了类似的邀请函。

一旦收到所有提名,我们将成立一个筛选委员会,以挑选海洋气象和海洋(met-ocean)预报或观测方面最具资格的专家。我们将优先考虑来自印度洋和西太平洋区域的申请人。如仍有空席,则会考虑来自其他地区的申请人。甄选委员会将从2024年5月初起审议,随后将尽快通知选定的专家。
