FOR
EDUCATION AND TRAINING NATIONAL FOCAL POINTS (ET-NFPs)**

National education and training focal points are expected to assist the Permanent Representative of their country with WMO on areas such as the following:

1. Liaise with the Education and Training Office of the WMO and respond to periodic inquiries on education and training activities, including survey questionnaires on training needs and opportunities.
2. Promotion of education and training and fellowships matters within the NMHS.
3. Keep abreast of competency development and assessment issues and matters related to qualifications of personnel.
4. Collaborate with other experts, panels, associations, training institutions, Regional Training Centres etc. on education and training issues.
5. Identify needs, effectiveness and opportunities for face-to-face, online and distance learning programmes in meteorology, hydrology and climate services.
6. Keep under review the needs and opportunities of education and training as well as issues related to capacity development including Human Resources Development planning.
